ON 03-31-91 AT APPROXIMATELY 2035 HRS. I WAS NOTIFIED AT MY RESIDENCE BY DETECTIVE THOMAS OF AN ARMED ROBBERY HOMICIDE THAT HAD JUST OCCURRED AT THE CLARK OIL STATION LOCATED AT 802 EAST EMPIRE. I ADVISED DET. THOMAS THAT I WOULD BE LEAVING MY RESIDENCE AND IT WOULD BE THIRTY MINUTE ARRIVAL TIME TO THE SCENE. HE ADVISED ME THAT THE SCENE HAD BEEN SECURED AND WAS BEING HELD. AT APPROXIMATELY 0905 HRS. I REPORTED TO SGT. IRVIN AT THE SCENE AND WAS BRIEFED OF KNOWN INFORMATION REGARDING THIS CASE. I WAS ALSO ADVISED THAT CST ED KALLAL (ILLINOIS STATE POLICE) WOULD BE ARRIVING. FOLLOWING BRIEFING CST KALLAL ON THE SCENE IT WAS DECIDED THAT I WOULD START BY TAKING STATIC LIFTS OF THE CONCRETE OUTSIDE THE DOOR (SOUTH SIDE AND MAIN ENTRANCE) AND THEN CONTINUE ON INSIDE THE BUILDING. STATIC LIFTS WERE TAKEN OF THE GREEN TILE FLOOR OF ALL POSSIBLY AFFECTED AREAS TO RECOVER ANY AND ALL FOOTWEAR PRINTS. THE STATIC LIFT SHEETS WERE THEN PLACED ON THE WALL INSIDE THE STATION UNTIL WE COULD FINISH AN AREA LARGE ENOUGH TO BEGIN PHOTOGRAPHING THESE LIFTS. THESE LIFTS WERE PHOTOGRAPHED BY CST R.D.MCKINLEY AND LOGGED BY CST E. KALLAL. FOLLOWING PHOTOGRAPHY I TURNED THIS EXPOSED FILM OVER TO CST KALLAL TO BE DELIVERED TO ISP PHOTO LAB IN SPRINGFIELD FOR DEVELOPMENT. I ASSISTED CST KALLAL IN THE REMAINING PROCESSING OF THE SCENE. I WAS THEN SENT TO SIX POINTS ROAD AND ALEXANDER ROAD TO LOOK AT FOOTWEAR IMPRESSIONS FOUND IN MUD NEAR A RECOVERED STOLEN VEHICLE (91-002148) IT IS UNKNOWN IF THIS IS RELATED.
