N	On 9 April 91, at approximately 1235 hrs., contact was made with <u>and her daughter,</u> at BPD by Det Crowe and Det Ronnfeldt regarding any possible new informat- ion. <u>had brought with her various slips of paper found in</u> <u>Bill's wallet, most containing different phone numbers and names.</u> <u>also stated that she remembered who Tom Ryburn was; he is married to</u> <u>her mother's cousin, she had forgotten due to the stress from the earlier</u> <u>meeting with us today.</u> <u>stated, when asked, that she had received a traffic</u> <u>citation by Heyworth PD in August 1990 for illegal transportation and</u> <u>had in her vehicle at the time of the stop a Nicki Sage and a Willie</u> <u>Jesse, both of Bloomington, IL. She described Jesse as having dark, long</u> <u>hair, tall being about 25 years of age. She also stated that she did not</u> <u>feel that Jesse looked liked the composite at all, nor did she know his</u> <u>address or where he could be found.</u> <u>When questioned about Bill's possible involvement in the Sunoco or</u> <u>Molly's break-ins, she stated that Bill told her he had no involvement</u> <u>in either but was aware of who was in the Molly's incident.</u> <u>She also stated she knew of the incident Bill was involved in during</u> <u>the summer of 1989 while he was still in high school. Bill was apparent-</u> <u>ly receiving troubles from a girl named Shannon Samples(now Wendt) and</u> <u>her then boyfriend Chad Wendt, both from Geneva, Ill. Chad Wendt,</u> <u>according to Susan, threatened violence</u>
