#1	One 22 caliber Harrington and Richardson Model "Sportsman" revolver, Serial Number #85487	Exhibit #1 was examined, test fired and found to be in poor mechanical operating condition with erratic single action operation, in that the hammer will not always lock back. Exhibit #1 could not have fired the bullets submitted in Exhibit #10 of Laboratory Case #P91-0751 due to a significant difference in class characteristics.




