Exhibit #1 was examined, test fired and found to be in good mechanical operating condition. It should be noted that Exhibit #1 was covered with rust spots. Six rounds of Laboratory ammunition were used for test firing and marked #1T1 through #1T6. Based on significant differences in class characteristics. Exhibit #1
