The following is a summary of the analytical findings:

#1	Sealed brown paper bag	Exhibit #1 was not analyzed at this time and is pending submission of additional evidence and will be the subject of a separate report.
#10A, #10B	Two fired 22 caliber bullets	Exhibits #10A and #10B were examined and determined to be 22 LR caliber copper washed bullets with rifling characteristics of 8 lands and grooves with right hand twist.

The following is a partial list of manufactured 22 LR caliber weapons whose barrels would impress characteristics similar to those found on Exhibits #10A and #10B: Rohm, RG Ind, Liberty Arms, Coovey Arms, Arminius, Burgo, Kimel, American Firearms, Gecado, PIC and Dickson.

We recommend that you submit any and all weapons subsequently obtained for examination.
