On 06-22-08 at 0649 hours, dispatched requested me to go to 1101 Stevenson Drive (Qik-N-Ez) in reference to a theft report.

I arrived and spoke with the victim, ██████ told me he arrived at Qik-n-Ez to shop. ██████ said he walked inside and purchased two newspapers and a coffee. ██████ said he walked out the front door when he was approached by a ██████ male. ██████ said the ██████ male asked him a question, which ██████ said he could not hear. ██████ said the ██████ male again asked a question. ██████ said the ██████ male asked him about buying something. ██████ said he told the ██████ male "No." ██████ said he turned around and started to walk away when the ██████ male pushed him toward his car from behind. ██████ said the ██████ male reached in his left back pocket and stole his wallet. ██████ he turned around and the ██████ male ran to the west side of the building and got into the back seat of a silver vehicle. ██████ said a ██████ woman came up and asked him if he was okay. ██████ said they went inside Qik-n-Ez and called the police.

I spoke with ██████ said she was pumping gas when she saw ██████ come out of the store and walk toward his car. ██████ said a ██████ male approached ██████ as he got close to his car. ██████ said after the ██████ male spoke to ██████ for a short time ██████ turned away from the black male. ██████ said the ██████ male followed ██████ and then pushed ██████ from behind and took ██████ wallet from him and ran to the side of the business. ██████ said she saw the ██████ male get into the back seat of a silver sport utility vehicle. ██████ said the vehicle left northbound on 11th street. ██████ said she ran to ██████ to see if he was hurt. ██████ said ██████ said he was okay so they went inside and called the police. ██████ said the silver SUV had damage to the left rear of it and had a black mark on the rear bumper.

I spoke with ██████ manager of Qik N Ez. I asked ██████ if she witnessed what occurred outside. ██████ told me she did not. ██████ did say the suspects were in the store trying to cash a check. ██████ said the name on the check was ██████ but she did not know the address on the check. ██████ said ██████ was with two other ██████ males. ██████ said she gathered pictures from the surveillance cameras. ██████ said the cameras did not capture the crime but did have the suspect vehicle in the lot. The camera also captured ██████ and another ██████ male at the counter inside the store. ██████ printed copies of the pictures for me.

I left the store and tried to locate the vehicle in the area. I ran computer checks on ██████ males named ██████ in the area. I located several ██████ living in the area. I started checking addresses the computer showed. I located one in the 2000 block of East Adams. There were not any vehicles in the area matching the description. I drove to the 2000 block of East Capital where another ██████ registered at in the computer. I had dispatch run an inquiry on a vehicle in the driveway of 2016 East Capital. The inquiry came back to the last name of ██████ I did not see the suspect vehicle though. I drove east on Capital and turned south on Wheeler. I looked in my rear view mirror and saw a vehicle matching the description. I turned around and got behind the vehicle.

The suspect vehicle turned west on Capital. I activated my emergency lights. The vehicle stopped in front of 2016 East Capital. I waited for back up to arrive. Deputies Buecker, Bartello and Roderick arrived.

We conducted a felony traffic stop on the occupants of the car. The driver, Maurice Johnson, was taken into custody first. Deputy Bartello placed him into his car. The passenger, ██████ was taken into custody by Deputy Buecker and placed ██████ into her vehicle.

At 0902 hours, ██████ and Maurice were advised of their Miranda rights. I spoke with ██████ first.

I asked ██████ if he could tell me what occurred at Qik n Ez. ██████ said he was inside Qik n Ez trying to cash a check. ██████ said he could not get it cashed so he went outside and got in the car. ██████ said ██████ pulled around the side of the building to leave when ██████ said he had to go to the bathroom. They stopped on the side of the building and ██████ got out of the car. A short time later ██████ jumped into the back seat of the car and said "get me out of here." ██████ said they drove around for a while and that is when they were stopped by me. ██████ said he did not do anything wrong and he said "I just wanted to cash a check." ██████ said he has no idea what ██████ did.

I spoke with Maurice. I asked Maurice what happened at Qik N Ez. Maurice told me it was my job to find out what happened and wasn't going to talk to me.

I spoke with Detective Lieutenant Roesch. Lieutenant Roesch said based on ██████ statement we had enough probable cause to arrest Maurice. Deputy Roderick completed a tow inventory sheet and followed the vehicle to the Sangamon County Garage, where it is being held for evidence.

While we were releasing ██████ rode up to us on his bicycle. ██████ said he heard that we stopped Maurice's car and arrested him. ██████ didn't do anything. I said "How do you know this?" ██████ told me he was with ██████ this morning at Qik N Ez. I asked ██████ what happened. ██████ told me ██████ needed some money so they went to cash a check at Qik N Ez. ██████ said they went inside but couldn't get any money so they went to leave. ██████ said they pulled around to the side of the building when Maurice said wait I need to go inside so I can go to the bathroom. ██████ said he stopped the car and Maurice got out. ██████ said Maurice was gone for a little while and he started to get out of the car to find Maurice when Maurice came around the side of the building, jumped into the car and said "get me out of here, now." ██████ said he took off down the road because he is paper (parole) and doesn't need any problems. ██████ said they turned off by some tracks and drove around for a while. ██████ said he looked in the back seat and saw Maurice looking through a wallet. ██████ said Maurice started to throw the stuff inside the wallet out the passenger window of the car.

I asked ██████ where the wallet was at now. ██████ told me he doesn't know where Maurice threw it out at. ██████ told me I could find the contents of the wallet along the road by Bunn Golf Course and maybe in the patch area. I let ██████ go but gathered his information for this report. I left the area to locate the stolen items.

I drove to the area of Bunn Golf Course. I, along with Deputies Buecker and Bartello and Lieutenant Brown walked from the intersection of Stanford and Foxbridge to the intersection of 15th and Glenn. We located numerous items from the wallet on the roadway. We located insurance cards, social security card, victim's Illinois Drivers Licence, and medical cards. We could not locate the wallet in the area. I collected the items and placed into evidence. I left the area.

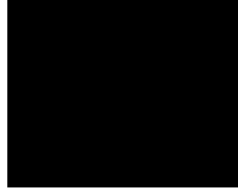

Approximately 5:05P, 07-08-08, R/D (Sgt. R.W. Vose) and Detective Rod Vose met with [REDACTED] at his residence at [REDACTED] Springfield. This was in regards to a robbery incident at the Qik N EZ Station at 1101 Stevenson Drive Springfield. The robbery occurred at approximately 6:30A, 06-22-08.

At that time [REDACTED] (83 YOA) was shoved and his wallet taken from his pants pocket by a [REDACTED] M subject. A witness saw the suspect go to a silver colored SUV occupied by two other subjects and leave the area north bound on 11th Street. Approximately 2 hours later Deputies stopped a vehicle matching this description in front of [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] was a passenger in the vehicle driven by Maurice E. Johnson [REDACTED] Deputies arrested Johnson and charged him with the robbery. Deputies spoke briefly with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who rode up on a bicycle.

[REDACTED] stated to R/D's that in the early morning of 06-22-08 [REDACTED] and "Reese" (later determined to be Maurice Johnson) came to his residence to pick him up. They were in a silver SUV that [REDACTED] believed belonged to Johnson. They were planning to go register for a 3 on 3 basketball tournament. They drove around a while and eventually went to the Qik N EZ Station at 11th/Stevenson, Springfield. [REDACTED] stated that at some point [REDACTED] was driving the vehicle.

At the Qik N EZ Station all three went inside and [REDACTED] attempted to cash a personal check to purchase cigarettes and food. He stated he presented two I.D.'s but the clerk declined to cash the check, as they were leaving Johnson asked [REDACTED] to drive. Deputy Law's report reflected that both [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was driving as they left the station. At this time [REDACTED] was emphatic that he was driving the silver SUV from the Qik N EZ. [REDACTED] stated that as he turned around the corner of the building towards 11th Street, Johnson told him to stop as he needed to use the bathroom. Johnson exited the vehicle and walked back around the corner of the building. Two or three minutes later Johnson returned and got in the back seat of the vehicle. [REDACTED] then drove north bound on 11th Street. [REDACTED] stated he was no aware that anything had happened at the station.

A short time later as [REDACTED] drove along side a golf course (Bunn Park) he observed Johnson throwing papers out the window of the moving vehicle. They then dropped off [REDACTED] and Johnson drove around awhile.

Approximately 2 hours after the robbery, Deputy Law observed the vehicle and stopped it in front of [REDACTED] residence. At that time Johnson was driving. While speaking with the Deputies [REDACTED] learned about the robbery of the old man at the Qik N EZ. [REDACTED] stated that neither he nor [REDACTED] had any involvement in the robbery. He stated he did not even know it had occurred until stopped by police.

(See separate report on the line up) Prior to the line up R/D interviewed [REDACTED] in regards to the robbery to obtain a more detailed statement.

[REDACTED] stated that it is his normal routine on Sunday's to go to the Qik-N-EZ station at 11th/Stevenson early in the morning. He buys two newspapers and a cup of coffee. On the morning of 06-22-08 [REDACTED] exited the station and walked to his vehicle parked out front. He was approached by a [REDACTED] M subject offering to sell him something. [REDACTED] said the subject was holding something in his left hand but he could not tell what it was. [REDACTED] told the subject he didn't want to buy anything. Suddenly [REDACTED] felt his wallet being pulled out of his left rear pants pocket. The [REDACTED] M subject then ran west bound with the wallet. [REDACTED] yelled at the subject that there was no money in the wallet. The [REDACTED] M subject then ran north bound around the corner of the station building and out of [REDACTED] view. [REDACTED] believed that the subject was wearing long pants and a dark blue shirt.

[REDACTED] stated that while inside the station he observed two [REDACTED] M subjects but didn't know if the subject who took his wallet was one of them. Prior to [REDACTED] leaving the Sheriff's Department, R/D returned evidence item #2 to him. There were cards in his name including an Illinois Driver's License and other papers that had been in his wallet when it was stolen. R/D will attach a photo copy of these items to this report. R/D also returned [REDACTED] CareMark card that R/D had recovered from the floorboard of Maurice Johnson's vehicle.

ON 06-22-08 ██████████ (83 YOA) was robbed in the parking lot of the Qik-N-EZ Station. The station has surveillance cameras and the suspect vehicle and two of the suspects associates were captured on surveillance video. The actual robbery was not.

Deputy Law spoke with ██████████ that morning and she advised him that the technician who can make copies of the video was not available till next week. At the time she was able to provide four still photos (color) to the Deputy. Two photos show the suspect vehicle in the parking lot. Two other photos show two ██████████ M subjects inside the store near the service counter. At this time the two ██████████ M's are believed to be ██████████ and ██████████. The robbery suspect is Maurice E. Johnson ██████████

When R/D spoke with ██████████ she stated that the surveillance video had been erased when the technician attempted to copy it. She stated there was no way to retrieve any of it.

On the afternoon of 06-23-08, R/D (Sgt. R.W. Vose) was assisting Sgt. Mike Pennington on a detail at the S.C.S.O. Repair Garage. During this time R/d observed a gray 2000 Mitsubishi Montero Sport 4 door parked in the garage. The vehicle bore Illinois license [REDACTED] R/D knew this to be a vehicle towed by Deputy Law after the arrest of the driver, Maurice Johnson, for robbery on 06-22-08. Per S.C.S.O. policy the vehicle should have been searched and it's contents inventoried. The vehicle should also have been photographed.

As R/d stood next to the passenger side front door a black tri-fold type wallet was observed on the seat. R/D found this to be very unusual. R/D opened the wallet and observed the following items inside of it.

Social Security Card [REDACTED] in the name of Maurice Eugene Johnson

Capital One Platinum Mastercard credit card – Maurice E. Johnson

CEFCU CUCard – Maurice E. Johnson

Business card of Mclean County Probation Officer Michelle H. Lindenmeier

R/D also saw a white card on the passenger side front floorboard of the vehicle. Picking it up R/D observed that it was a CareMark Pharmacy Card in the name of the robbery victim [REDACTED]

Seeing these items in plain view in the vehicle led R/D to believe that a proper inventory search of the vehicle had not been done.

The following morning 06-24-08, R/D met with Deputy Law, Deputy Roderick and their supervisor Sgt. Yanor in the Detective Bureau Office. At this time Deputy Law said he believed that Deputy Roderick was going to complete the inventory search after following the towed vehicle to the S.C.S.O. Garage.

Deputy Roderick stated that after the towed vehicle was placed in the garage the only action he took was to remove the suspects I.D. from the wallet that R/D observed on the seat. He did not conduct a proper inventory search nor did he arrange for photographs to be taken.

Approximately 1:55P, 06-24-08, R/D and Sgt. Knowski returned to the Sheriff's Garage to conduct a proper inventory search of the vehicle and photograph it. R/D removed only one item from the vehicle at this time.

One Ace brand silver colored key found on the rear floor board.
