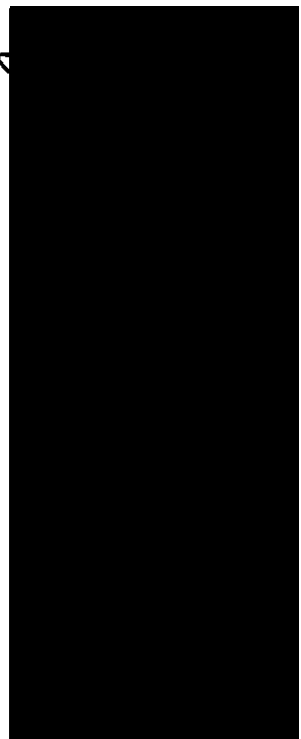
Please let me know if Bill's case is open, I feel very unhappy that Snow or the other person walk on this to this day.
