On April 19, 1999, \_\_\_\_\_ met with Detective Dan Katz and myself at the Bloomington Police Department. While at the Bloomington Police Department, \_\_\_\_\_ was escorted to the Criminal Investigation Division, where the following interview took place. The purpose of the interview was to document information that \_\_\_\_\_ witnessed, in reference to the above incident.

Prior to being interviewed, \_\_\_\_\_ went with Detective Dan Katz and myself to 807 E. Empire Street to show us where \_\_\_\_\_ was standing in order to observe the suspect leaving the gas station. It should be noted that it is possible to view the Clark gas station from the northwest bedroom window that \_\_\_\_\_ stated he looked out and observed the suspect fleeing.

After viewing the area, \_\_\_\_\_ was escorted back to the Bloomington Police Department and escorted to the Criminal Investigation Division where, I explained to \_\_\_\_\_ that I would like to tape record the interview. \_\_\_\_\_ gave me permission to tape recorded the interview. Present during the tape recorded interview were Detective Dan Katz, myself (Detective Rick Barkes) and \_\_\_\_\_. The interview took place at 1110 hours on April 19, 1999.

In narrative, \_\_\_\_\_ stated the following:

On March 31, 1991, \_\_\_\_\_ was living at \_\_\_\_\_ informed me that he was with his nephew \_\_\_\_\_ at 807 E. Empire Street looking out \_\_\_\_\_ bedroom window (front northwest window) looking towards the gas station, when observed a white male suspect exit the gas station. \_\_\_\_\_ continued by telling me that it appeared that the suspect was holding something inside his (suspect unknown) jacket with his right hand. \_\_\_\_\_ then stated that when the suspect got to the southeast corner of the gas station, the suspect turned north and after making the turn took off running north.

\_\_\_\_\_ stated that he made the comment to \_\_\_\_\_ that he thought that the guy had just robbed the gas station jokingly and really didn't think anything about it until \_\_\_\_\_ heard the sirens a short time after the suspect left the area. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that the reason he was looking out the window was because his ex-sister in law \_\_\_\_\_ usually works on Sundays and they thought about going over to the gas station to get some candy.

\_\_\_\_\_ described the suspect as being a white male subject wearing a trench coat down to the suspects' ankles, a black baseball cap, white tennis shoes and blue jeans. \_\_\_\_\_ continued by telling me that the suspect was about 5'10" to 5'11", collar length hair and thin built.

\_\_\_\_\_ stated that when he was looking out the window and observed the suspect coming out of the gas station, \_\_\_\_\_ did not observe any vehicles in the lot. At least not that he recalls.

I also asked \_\_\_\_\_ about the in person line up that \_\_\_\_\_ viewed at the McLean County Jail. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that he remember viewing the line up which consisted of 6 white males. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that he looked at each individual and imaged them doing it and \_\_\_\_\_ picked #6 as being the suspect. \_\_\_\_\_ still believes that #6 is the suspect.

When the above tape recorded interview was completed \_\_\_\_\_ was allowed to leave the Bloomington Police Department. The interview was concluded at 1123 hours on April 19, 1999. I then placed the tape recorded interview into evidence on May 04, 1999.
