N AT ABOUT 1345 HRS. 4/1/91 I INTERVIEWED [REDACTED] AT THE BLOOMINGTON POLICE STATION. BOTH BOYS HAD WITNESSED A M/W SUSPECT RUN EAST + NORTH FROM THE CLACK STATION AT LINDEN + EMPIRE AT ABOUT 2020 HRS ON 3/31/91. THEY OBSERVED THE INCIDENT FROM ACROSS THE STREET AT A DIAGONAL FROM THE STATION FROM INSIDE 407 E. EMPIRE. THEY WERE ABOUT 100' AWAY FROM THE MAN. THEY SAID HE CARRIED SOMETHING IN HIS HANDS AS HE RAN. THE BOYS ADMITTED BEING AFRAID OF REPRISAL IF THEY IDENTIFIED THE SUSPECT BUT DOUBTED THAT HE COULD ANYWAY. [REDACTED] THOUGHT HE MIGHT BE ABLE TO WHILE BEING INTERVIEWED ALONE BUT HE COULD OFFER ALMOST NO DETAILS. BOTH BOYS WERE SHOWN COMPOSITE #1 + 2 FROM THE INCIDENT AND COMPOSITE #1 FROM THE ARMED ROBBERY IN DECEMBER. THEY SAID COMPOSITE #1 FROM THE LATEST ROBBERY LOOKED MOST LIKE WHAT THEY SAW. NO COMPOSITE WAS MADE FROM EITHER BOYS DESCRIPTION.
