

Affidavit of Ed Palumbo

I Ed Palumbo, under oath and penalty of perjury, state as follows:

1. My name is Ed Palumbo.
2. I have known Jamie Snow since the 1980s. We were friends in Bloomington.
3. I don't believe Jamie did this crime. He is not a killer.
4. I signed a statement about Jamie telling me he did this because the police told me that Jamie already told them he talked to me. At the time I was trying to get a deal on other charges I had.
5. I didn't want to testify in court but the Bloomington Police and state's attorney told me if I didn't testify I would be put in segregation in prison, be charged with perjury or get five years in prison for not cooperating.
6. If Jamie's attorney had come talk to me before trial I would have told him that I knew Jamie was bullshitting. I would have told him that I knew Jamie didn't do this.
7. At the time I testified I was pissed that I had to take an eleven hour bus ride to court. I was still trying to get a deal for myself.

8. After I testified, Charles Reinhard told me that Jamie Snow didn't do this, someone else had, but since they couldn't get that other person Jamie would have to do.

9. At the time I testified I thought if I cooperated with the government I could get a deal on my sentence or at least be transferred. Before I testified Reinhard said if there was any prison I wanted to go to he would see what he could do.

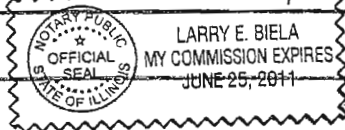
10. I only said what I said because I thought Jamie had already talked about this to the police and I didn't see how this could hurt him. I know what I said was what they wanted to hear.
