On 03/18/99 R/O and Det. Sgt. Ron Maaks went to Tamms Correctional Center to interview [redacted]. Upon arrival we met with Internal Affairs Officer Kevin Verble who walked us to the "Farm" where [redacted] was housed. We entered one of the many buildings which are located outside of the actual prison. Officer Verbal took us to a office where we met with [redacted].

On 03/18/99 at 8:25 A.M. [redacted] was escorted into the office where our conversation took place. Present during this interview were R/O (Det. Dan Katz), Det. Sgt. Ron Maaks, Internal Affairs Officer Kevin Verble and Inmate Ed Palumbo. R/O explained to [redacted] why we were there which was to discuss what he knew about the Armed Robbery / Murder at the Clark station in 1991. [redacted] stated he had blanked out all of that stuff as he was to old for that nonsense as all he wanted to do was to do his time and get on with his life. R/O explained to [redacted] the lead Detective had retired and R/O had recently been assigned to assist in this investigation. R/O went on to tell [redacted] R/O was starting from the beginning which meant R/O had to talk with everyone that had already been interviewed by the other Detectives. [redacted] again expressed his desire not to be involved in this case as he did not know the victim and the victim did not mean anything to him.

R/O informed [redacted] that R/O knew [redacted] had some information regarding this case and he could either tell R/O what he knew today or the States Attorney Office could writ him back to Bloomington to testify in front of the Grand Jury if they so desired. R/O went on to say even if [redacted] told R/O what he knew there was a possibility [redacted] would still have to testify in front of the Grand Jury. R/O asked [redacted] what R/O wanted to know? R/O asked [redacted] if he remembered the conversation he had with Jamie Snow on Morris Avenue? [redacted] stated yes. R/O asked [redacted] if it was true that Jamie said, "did you see me in the paper" and you said no. [redacted] stated that he remembered that and that was a true statement. R/O asked [redacted] if he remembered Jamie Snow saying the gun went off and the kid died. [redacted] again stated that was a true statement.

R/O asked [redacted] if he could remember anything else that was said at that time on Morris Ave. when he was standing there talking to Jamie Snow? [redacted] stated he was not standing when he had the conversation with Snow he was in a car. R/O asked [redacted] if he remembered Shannon Schmidt hearing this conversation and [redacted] stated he was not sure if she could have heard the conversation because Snow was not talking that loud. R/O asked about Shannon Schmidt and [redacted] stated he did not want to talk about Shannon.

Our conversation with [redacted] was ended and we left Tamms Correctional Center.
