On December 19, 1999, Detective Dan Katz and myself (Detective Rick Barkes) went to Orlando Florida to interview _____ in reference to the above incident. We located _____ at his residence and after we identified ourselves as being Detectives from the Bloomington Police Department in Bloomington, Illinois, _____ allowed us into his apartment.

Once inside _____ apartment, we explained to _____ that there has been an arrest in the Clark Oil Gas Station shooting that took place on March 31, 1991. We also explained to _____ that the purpose for us coming to Orlando, Florida was to go over _____ statement. _____ stated he would cooperate. We explained to _____ that we wanted to tape record the interview with him _____ gave us permission to tape record his interview.

The tape recorded interview began at 2201 hours on December 19th, 1999. Present during this interview were Detective Dan Katz, Detective Rick Barkes and _____

In _____ interview, _____ stated that on Easter Sunday (March 31, 1991) he left his residence and went to the Clark Gas Station on Empire Street to put some gas into his car. _____ stated that he put into his car about \$3.00 worth of gas. When he went into pay for the gas there was another individual in the gas station besides the gas station attendant. _____ gave the police and assist the police in drawing a sketch of the person in the gas station. _____ stated that he believe this to be around 1900 hours. _____ stated that he did not recall any other cars in the gas station lot while he _____ was there. _____ stated that he then left the gas station and went to a friends house on West Mulberry. _____ stated that he was at his friends house for about an hour and a half to two hours. _____ stated that he left and was on his way back home when he observed everything going at the Clark Gas Station. _____ stated that he parked his car a half a block away and talked to a police officer and explained to the officer what _____ observed earlier. _____ then came to the police department to give a statement and assist in a composite.

We also talked to _____ about the mug shots that he looked at and the books of photographs that were compiled in this case. _____ stated that he could not positively identify anyone because he only observe the suspect for a brief period of time. _____ also stated that mug shot that he pointed out was only similar to the person he observed in the gas station, not that the person was the suspect. _____ did state that the suspect could have been in the books however, unless the angle of the person or the clothes of the person were the same, he would not have been able to identify the person. _____ stated that he was just trying his best to help.

For additional information review _____ tape recorded statement. The tape recorded interview was concluded at 2220 hours on December 19th, 1999. The tape recorded interview was placed into evidence by Detective Barkes on January 05, 2000.
